




Weekly Worship Service each Sunday at 10:30 a.m. February 17, 2019

annual meeting, the congregation or pastoral charge is responsible for (a) electing a chair and a secretary of the annual meeting; (b) receiving the annual reports from the governing body, committees, and other groups in the congregation or pastoral charge; (c) electing the governing body and Regional representatives; and (d) considering and making a decision on the draft annual budget".


