
By policy, the Minister is an automatic member of the Board of Trustees

Being Stewards of God's Earth //

A recent study suggests that humans consume up to 74,000 microplastic particles each year. Toxic chemicals in these microplastics are absorbed by our bodies and may lead to human health effects. Let's get involved and speak to local representatives. It works! In 2018, microbeads were banned in a number of products--including facial scrubs, toothpastes, and body lotions--in response to public demand. Canada has recently launched a plan to ban harmful single-use plastics by 2021. If you want more information about what can be done with the problem of plastics, there are a number of organizations that are working to address the problem, such as Environmental Defence (at https://environmentaldefence.ca/campaign/ending-plastic-pollution).
