

A Sunday service can include **Communion** (Sandra K-C) and **Baptism** (Ava T) as well as Minute for Mission and Stewardship. Ensuring there are Greeters (Patti L) for the front door and candle lighters is another role under the Worship Team umbrella. Handing out bulletins and aiding people to their seats as well as helping to collect the offering is the job of the Ushers (Ed R) and after service there is **Coffee/Tea/Juice** (Heather M) offered to everyone. The revised year-end operating budget is a deficit of approximately \$8,000 versus the original nearly-balanced operating budget. This is due to extra costs associated with repairs to two access ramps, a catch basin, and unexpected building repairs.
