# Concerned about energy efficiency? Here are some helpful ideas ...

One person contributes as much heat as a 100 watt heater: so invite your friends over! In the kitchen: your refrigerator and freezer are more energy efficient when they are full. Use water and ice cubes to fill up the space. Cook in quantity: when you bake, keep both racks full.

Small appliances such as a slow cooker, bread maker and pressure cooker are considerably more efficient than their larger equivalents.

In the message section, please specify what the money is for (i.e. Local Fund, Building Fund, Mission & Service, Foodbank, Special Appeal, etc.). If you require a tax receipt, please include your mailing address if your contact information is not already on file with the church office.
- \* Via debit or credit card by going to **westminster-uc.ca/give/** and click on the "GIVE ONLINE" button.
- \* Via debit or credit by visiting the gym after service or stopping by the office Monday through Friday during office hours.
- \* Donation receipts for offerings/donations of \$20 or more (cumulative) are issued in February of the following year in which the offering/donation is made.


