If you are thinking about joining in-person worship, please consider the following:

Before you come to the Church

- Following provincial guidelines, we are allowed 30% of seating capacity in the sanctuary. Spaced seating has been arranged for 80 congregants. Each household is asked to reserve seating before attending each Sunday to ensure appropriate numbers and to provide contact information should a COVID-19 outbreak occur.
- You can reserve on the Westminster website or by calling the church office, 905-723-6442. Instructions for reserving on the website are attached to this email.
- There will be health related screening questions during registration to ensure health safety for all. If you aren't feeling well, please stay home.
- Out of an abundance of caution we are following Durham Region guidelines for being in public buildings and ask that you wear your mask at Westminster during worship. Please bring your mask with you. We understand that for medical reasons some are unable to wear masks. If you are in a vulnerable or at-risk group we invite you to worship online from home.
- The church will be cleaned and sanitized prior to your arrival.

While at the Church

- Please use hand sanitizer before entry into the main building. It will be provided.
- We have been missing social time with each other but please remember to maintain a minimum distance of six feet apart of other families when in the church and in the parking lot.
- After confirming your registration, ushers will show you to your seat.
- Children attending in-person worship are to remain seated with their family group in the sanctuary throughout the service.
- Offering stations will be set up in the sanctuary.
- The projection screen will share Order of Service information.
- At this time there will be no coffee/tea fellowship time after the service.
